The Court orders that the motion to dismiss this appeal is DENIED. Because the decision of the township board to approve a special use permit in this matter was made at a public hearing, not an adversarial hearing, and did not involve procedural characteristics common to courts, such as a right to call witnesses, the township board did not act as a tribunal in this matter. Thus, MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a) does not bar an appeal of right as to the September 4, 2019 order appealed from. *Natural Resources Defense Council v Dep't of Environmental Quality*, 300 Mich App 79, 86-87; 832 NW2d 288 (2013). Further, because the September 4, 2019 order is the first circuit court order disposing of all claims in this case, it is a final order appealable of right to this Court. MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i); MCR 7.203(A).
