On remand, for the reasons stated in the Michigan Supreme Court's Order issued December 30, 2019, the Court orders that the complaint for mandamus relief is GRANTED. The recall petition is proper because the reasons given for recall in the circulated petitions were not different than the reasons that were approved by the Board of Canvassers. Defendants erred by finding the form of the recall petition insufficient under MCL 168.961(2)(c) and must accept the petitions despite the difference between the language of the circulated petition and the reasons for recall approved by the Board of State Canvassers. This ruling is limited to the issues raised in the complaint for mandamus and brief in support filed December 2, 2019.

This order is to have immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2).

We do not retain jurisdiction.
