The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion to intervene is GRANTED. Larry Inman is added as an intervening defendant in this matter.

The complaint for mandamus relief is GRANTED in part as follows. Secretary of State and Director or Elections shall allow filing of challenges against the sufficiency of the recall petition on or before January 8, 2020. Defendant Secretary of State shall issue a call for a Recall Primary and Recall election, if supported, on January 10, 2010. Democratic party candidate must file for the Recall Primary by 4:00 p.m. January 13, 2020. Defendant Secretary of State shall certify the March 10, 2020 ballot, including any Democratic Party candidates who filed for the Recall Primary, by January 13, 2020. These deadlines are extended to preserve plaintiff's rights under Const 1963, art 2, 88 and to completely implement the Michigan Supreme Court's order issued December 30, 2019 and this Court's order issued January 2, 2020 in Hardy v Secretary Of State, docket number 351694.

This order is to have immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2).

The Court retains no further jurisdiction because there are currently no additional issues to address.
