The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented.

Although the trial court erred when it stated that it was not required to articulate any reason for exceeding the sentencing guidelines when imposing sentence on a probation violation, (see e.g., *People v* Schomaker, 495 Mich 1001; 846 NW2d 53 (2014)), it nevertheless did articulate sufficient reasons to justify the upward departure sentence imposed and the sentence was proportional. *People v Steanhouse*, 500 Mich 453; 902 NW2d 327 (2017).
