The Court orders that the *in propria persona* motion to remand is GRANTED as follows: The trial court shall allow defendant to add the issues raised in defendant's *in propria persona* motion to remand to the issues upon which this Court has already granted a remand hearing. Proceedings on remand are limited to the issues raised in the *in propria persona* motion to remand and the issues upon which this Court has already granted a remand. This Court retains jurisdiction.

Defendant shall make an appropriate filing in the trial court within 14 days after the date of this order regarding the additional issues to be considered on remand. As provided in this Court's December 3, 2020 order, defendant shall file with this Court a copy of any motion and supporting brief filed in the trial court, and defendant shall file a copy of any order entered within 14 days after its entry. If defendant fails to file a motion to enlarge the scope of the remand hearing by adding additional issues within the time provided, the remand hearing shall proceed as provided in this Court's December 3, 2020 order without consideration of defendant's additional issues.

The trial court shall make an appropriate determination on the record and cause a transcript of any proceedings on remand to be prepared at public expense and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings. Defendant may file a supplemental brief within 21 days after the court's decision disposing of all issues on remand or the filing of the transcript of all proceedings held on remand, whichever occurs later.

The motion for immediate consideration of the motion to extend time within which to complete remand is GRANTED. The motion to extend time within which to complete remand is GRANTED until May 20, 2021.
