MEMORANDUM.

Defendant Secretary of State appeals as of right the order of the circuit court requiring defendant to issue plaintiff, holder of a valid driver's license, a vehicle group designation upon plaintiff's satisfactory completion of the required examination, despite the fact that plaintiff's license had been revoked or suspended in the preceding thirty-six months. We reverse.

The present case is indistinguishable from *Taylor v Secretary of State*, ___ Mich App ___; ___ NW2d ___ (1996) (Docket No. 173487, issued 4/19/96). For the reasons set forth therein, we reverse.

Reversed.
