MEMORANDUM.

Defendant pleaded nolo contendere to fourth-degree criminal sexual conduct, MCL 750.520e(1)(a); MSA 28.788(5)(1)(a), and was sentenced to sixteen to twenty-four months' imprisonment. He appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

Because the record indicates that defendant has fully served the minimum term of his sentence, his challenge to the proportionality of that sentence is moot. *People v Rutherford*, 208 Mich App 198; 526 NW2d 620 (1994).

Affirmed.
