MEMORANDUM.

Pursuant to a plea agreement, defendant pleaded guilty to two counts of delivery of less than fifty grams of cocaine, MCL 333.7401(2)(a)(iv); MSA 14.15(7401)(2)(a)(iv), for which he was sentenced to terms of five to twenty years' imprisonment and lifetime probation. He appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(E)(1)(b).

The trial court did not clearly err in finding that defendant was not entrapped. *People v Julliet*, 439 Mich 34; 475 NW2d 786 (1991); *People v Fabiano*, 192 Mich App 523; 482 NW2d 467 (1992). The record reflects that defendant was merely afforded an opportunity to commit the crimes. *People v D'Angelo*, 401 Mich 167, 172 n 4; 257 NW2d 655 (1977).

Affirmed.
