MEMORANDUM.

Pursuant to an agreement, defendant pleaded guilty of false pretenses over \$100, MCL 750.218; MSA 28.415, and habitual offender, third offense, MCL 769.11; MSA 28.1083. He was sentenced to four to twenty years' imprisonment, and now appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(E)(1)(b).

Defendant received the benefit of the sentencing agreement and so may not challenge the proportionality of his sentence. *People v Cobbs*, 443 Mich 276, 285 n 11; 505 NW2d 208 (1993); *People v Blount*, 197 Mich App 174, 175; 494 NW2d 829 (1992).

Affirmed.
