MEMORANDUM.

Defendant pleaded guilty to carjacking, MCL 750.529a; MSA 28.797(a), and possession of a firearm during the commission of a felony, MCL 750.227b; MSA 28.424(2). For those respective convictions, she was sentenced to three to five years' imprisonment and two years' consecutive imprisonment. She appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

Defendant's claim on appeal has not been preserved for review because she did not move for plea withdrawal below. *People v Nowicki*, 213 Mich App 383, 385; 539 NW2d 590 (1995).

Affirmed.
