MEMORANDUM.

Defendant pleaded nolo contendere to felonious assault, MCL 750.82; MSA 28.277, and was sentenced to three years' probation. After her second probation violation, the trial court revoked the probation and imposed a sentence of 1-1/2 to 4 years' imprisonment. Defendant appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

Defendant's sentence does not violate the principle of proportionality. *People v Merriweather*, 447 Mich 799; 527 NW2d 460 (1994); *People v Milbourn*, 435 Mich 630; 461 NW2d 1 (1990).

Affirmed.
