MEMORANDUM.

Pursuant to a plea agreement, defendant pleaded guilty of uttering and publishing, MCL 750.249; MSA 28.446, and habitual offender, second offense, MCL 769.10; MSA 28.1082. She was sentenced to seven to twenty-one years' imprisonment. She appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

Considering the circumstances of the offense and defendant's prior record and recidivism, her sentence does not violate the principle of proportionality. *People v Milbourn*, 435 Mich 630; 461 NW2d 1 (1990).

Affirmed.
