MEMORANDUM.

Defendant pleaded guilty of carrying a concealed weapon, MCL 750.227; MSA 28.424, and habitual offender, second offense, MCL 769.10; MSA 28.1082. He was sentenced to thirty-six to ninety months' imprisonment, and now appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

By tendering an unconditional guilty plea, defendant has waived any challenge to the validity of the search which resulted in the seizure of the evidence against him. *People v Harvey*, 203 Mich App 445; 513 NW2d 185 (1994).

Affirmed.
