MEMORANDUM.

Defendant, a juvenile, pleaded nolo contendere to involuntary manslaughter, MCL 750.321; MSA 28.553, and was sentenced as an adult to six to fifteen years' imprisonment. He appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

Defendant failed to preserve for appellate review his challenge to the scoring of the sentencing guidelines. *People v Grant*, 445 Mich 535; 475 NW2d 861 (1994); *People v Kaczorowski*, 190 Mich App 165, 173; 475 NW2d 861 (1991); MCR 6.429(C). In any event, there was adequate evidence supporting the trial court's scoring of 100 points for Offense Variable 6 for "multiple deaths." *People v Hernandez*, 443 Mich 1, 16-17; 503 NW2d 629 (1993); *People v Daniels*, 192 Mich App 658, 674; 482 NW2d 176 (1992).
