O'CONNELL, J. (concurring).

On appeal, defendant brings six allegations of error with respect to the proceedings below. Plaintiff has imprudently failed to respond to any of these allegations. Having reviewed the record, I am forced to conclude that arguments could have been made in support of the decisions of the court now alleged to constitute error. Plaintiff, however, failing even to file a brief on appeal, has not made these arguments. Given that this Court will not search for authority to support a party's position, *Isagholian v Transamerica Ins Corp*, 208 Mich App 9, 14; 527 NW2d 13 (1994), this Court will certainly not construct the argument a party should have brought where the party has failed to avail itself of its appellate rights. See MCR 7.212.

I concur in result only.
