I concur that this case should be reversed and remanded. It appears to me that the trial judge penalized the defendant three times for his unreasonable conduct. Plaintiff was awarded a 60/40 split instead of 50/50, the entire \$68,000 (without stating if it was marital property), and an \$8,000 attorney fee. I believe this was excessive and on remand, the trial judge should reconsider and assess a more appropriate sanction in pursuit of an equitable distribution of the property. *Sands v Sands*, 442 Mich 30; 497 NW2d 493 (1993).
