MEMORANDUM.

Pursuant to a plea agreement, defendant pleaded guilty to assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder, MCL 750.84; MSA 28.279, and habitual offender, second offense, MCL 769.10; MSA 28.1082. He was sentenced to eight to fifteen years' imprisonment, and now appeals as of right. We affirm. This case has been decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(A).

There is adequate evidence in the record to support the sentencing court's assessment of fifty points for Offense Variable 12 of the sentencing guidelines. *People v Reddish*, 181 Mich App 625, 628; 450 NW2d 16 (1989).

Affirmed.
