MEMORANDUM.

Respondent-appellant appeals as of right from the June 13, 1996 order of the probate court terminating his parental rights to the minor child under MCL 712A.19b(3)(a)(ii); MSA 27.3178(598.19b)(3)(a)(ii). We affirm.

Substituted service by publication in a newspaper in the county where the action was pending was proper under MCR 5.920(5)(c). Respondent-appellant has abandoned his argument that the probate court abused its discretion in terminating his parental rights by failing to argue that issue in his brief. *Mitcham v Detroit*, 355 Mich 182, 203; 94 NW2d 388 (1959).
