Defendant's sentence does not violate the principle of proportionality. *People v Hardy*, 212 Mich App 318; 537 NW2d 267 (1995); *People v Smith*, 195 Mich App 147; 489 NW2d 135 (1992). The sentence guidelines do not apply in the probation violation context, and any use of the guidelines in such circumstances would constitute a misapplication of a tool neither designed with probation violation in mind nor based on data which include probation violation sentences. *People v Edgett*, 220 Mich App 686; ___ NW2d ___ (1996).
