MEMORANDUM.

Respondent appeals by delayed leave granted from the juvenile court order terminating her parental rights to the minor children under MCL 712A.19b(3)(c)(i), (g) and (j); MSA 27.3178(598.19b)(3)(c)(i), (g) and (j). We affirm.

The findings of the juvenile court were not clearly erroneous. There was clear and convincing evidence to support the statutory grounds for termination. *In re Jackson*, 199 Mich App 22, 25; 501 NW2d 182 (1993). Further, the court did not clearly err in its decision to terminate respondent's parental rights. *Id.*; see also *In re Hall-Smith*, 222 Mich App 470, 472-473; 564 NW2d 156 (1997).

Affirmed.
