On order of the Court, the application for leave to appeal the August 23, 2016 judgment of the Court of Appeals is considered and, pursuant to MCR 7.305(H)(1), in lieu of granting leave to appeal, we REVERSE that part of the judgment of the Court of Appeals remanding this case to the trial court for a hearing pursuant to *People v Lockridge*, 498 Mich 358 (2015), and we REMAND this case to the Court of Appeals for plenary review of the defendant's claim that his sentence was disproportionate under the standard set forth in *People v Milbourn*, 435 Mich 630, 636 (1990). See *People v Steanhouse*, 500 Mich 453, 460-461 (2017). In all other respects, leave to appeal is DENIED, because we are not persuaded that the remaining questions presented should be reviewed by this Court.

We do not retain jurisdiction.
