The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is GRANTED, limited to the issues raised in the application. MCR 7.205(D)(4).

The Court orders that resolution of the appeal shall be EXPEDITED. MCR 7.204(D)(3)(b). The appellant's brief is due no later than 35 days from the Clerk's certification of this order. The appellee's brief is due no later than 21 days after service of the appellant's brief. No extensions of time will be allowed for filing of the briefs except by order of this Court. The Clerk of this Court is directed to place this case on the next available case call after the time to file appellee's brief has expired.

The Court further orders that the motion for stay is GRANTED. The effect and enforcement of the Ingham Circuit Court's March 24, 2006 ruling that invalidated 2004 MR 1, R 38.1205(1), and reinstated the pre-amended version of the rule, is STAYED pending resolution of this appeal or further order of this Court. MCR 7.209(D); 2.614(F)(1), (3).
