The Court orders that the “Motion to Remand and For a New Trial,” “Motion for Remand/Wade Hearing or in the Alternative Evidentiary Hearing,” and “Motion to Remand/Ginther Hearing” are DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the need to remand at this time.

The Court further orders that the “Motion to Remand for Motion for Peremptory Reversal,” which requests peremptory reversal pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(4), and the “Motion for Remand for Bond Pending Hearing,” which requests bond pending appeal pursuant to MCR 7.209(F)(2), are DISMISSED because they are not properly filed as *pro se* motions under Administrative Order 2004-6, Standard 4. Administrative Order 2004-6, Standard 4 permits a defendant in a criminal case to raise issues in a supplemental brief and permits the filing of an appropriate accompanying *pro se* motion. An appropriate accompanying motion is a motion that may be necessary to allow the effective review of the issues raised in the supplemental brief. Neither a motion that affects the timing of the submission of the *pro se* issues for decision, such as a motion for peremptory reversal under MCR 7.211(C)(4), nor a motion that is unrelated to any *pro se* issues, such as a motion for bond pending appeal, are appropriate *pro se* motions under Administrative Order 2004-6, Standard 4.
