The Court orders that the motion to remand pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(1) is GRANTED, and the matter is REMANDED to the trial court so that defendant-appellant may file, within 14 days, a motion for resentencing and for an award of additional sentence credit. Proceedings on remand are limited to the issues raised in the motion to remand.

Defendant-appellant shall file with this Court a copy of any motion and supporting brief filed in the trial court within 14 days after the Clerk's certification of this order. Defendant-appellant shall also file with the Clerk of this Court copies of all orders entered on remand within 14 days after entry. The trial court shall hear and decide the matter within 56 days after the Clerk's certification of this order. The trial court shall make findings of fact and a determination on the record and cause a transcript of any hearing on remand to be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings.

This Court retains jurisdiction in the cause, and the time for proceeding with the appeal in this Court begins upon issuance of an order in the trial court that finally disposes of the remand proceedings. If the appellant fails to file remand pleadings in the trial court within the 14-day period, the time for proceeding with the appeal in this Court begins 14 days from the date of certification of this order.
