The Court orders that the motion to amend the claim of appeal to a delayed application for leave to appeal is GRANTED in that the claim of appeal is treated as an application for leave to appeal. However, we note that, so treated, the application for leave to appeal was timely under MCR 7.205(A)(2) and, thus, constitutes a timely application for leave to appeal, not a delayed application.
