David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the May 15, 2012 probate court order denying a motion for reconsideration of an earlier April 12, 2012 order is not a final order appealable of right to this Court. See MCR 5.801(B). Further, the claim of appeal cannot be saved by treating it as taken from the April 12, 2012 order. The claim of appeal was not filed within 21 days after entry of the April 12, 2012 order, and the motion for reconsideration of that order was not filed within the initial 21-day appeal period or within further time allowed by the trial court. MCR 7.204(A)(1). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the underlying April 12, 2012 order to this Court only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
