In accordance with the Supreme Court order issued November 27, 2013, this matter is REMANDED to the St. Clair Circuit Court to conduct an evidentiary hearing to determine whether the issue raised by defendant merits the relief requested.

The trial court is to make findings of fact and a determination on the record. Upon making its decision, the St. Clair Circuit Court shall promptly provide the Court of Appeals with a copy of its findings. The trial court is to cause a transcript of any hearing on remand to be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings.

Appellant shall file his brief on appeal within 56 days of the filing of the transcript of the hearing with the circuit court or within 56 days of the filing of the circuit court's order, whichever is later. Appellee's brief is due 35 days after appellant's brief is served on appellee.

This Court retains jurisdiction.
