The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is GRANTED, limited to the issues raised in the application. MCR 7.205(D)(4). The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 7.205(D)(3).

Ronayne Krause, J., would deny the application for leave to appeal as there is a lack of merit in the grounds presented. There is great deference given to administrative agency decisions. *Glennon v State Employees' Retirement Bd*, 259 Mich App 476, 478-479; 674 NW2d 728 (2003). The stalking behavior exhibited by appellant was sufficient evidence for the Civil Service Commission to dismiss appellant's grievance, and therefore, the trial court should be affirmed.
