On the Court's own motion, this matter is REMANDED to the trial court so that appellant may file, within 14 days, a motion to settle the record. The trial court shall hold an evidentiary hearing at which the parties and the trial court will settle the record with regard to what portions of defendant's recorded interview with the police were played at the hearing on the motion to suppress held on November 9, 2012. The trial court shall cause a redacted DVD to be prepared that memorializes only those portions of the recording played for or otherwise heard by the court. The trial court shall enter the redacted DVD into the record and transmit the DVD to this Court within 14 days from the date of the evidentiary hearing.

Appellant is to file with this Court a copy of any motion and any supporting brief filed in the trial court within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

The trial court is to hear and decide the matter within 42 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.


This Court retains jurisdiction in the cause.
