The Court orders that the motion to withdraw as counsel pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(5) is DENIED because the Court finds, after a full examination of all proceedings, that the appeal is not wholly frivolous. Counsel for respondent-appellant shall have 28 days from the Clerk's certification of this order within which to file appellant's brief on appeal addressing the following issues:

I. WHETHER APPOINTED TRIAL COUNSEL RENDERED INEFFECTIVE ASSISTANCE OF COUNSEL WHERE COUNSEL HAD NO CONTACT WITH RESPONDENT FATHER FOR TEN MONTHS AFTER HER APPOINTMENT TO REPRESENT RESPONDENT FATHER AND ONLY MET WITH RESPONDENT FATHER AFTER THE TRIAL COURT AUTHORIZED THE FILING OF A SUPPLEMENTAL PETITION TO TERMINATION PARENTAL RIGHTS?

II. WHETHER THE ORDER OF TERMINATION MUST BE VACATED IN LIGHT OF *IN RE SANDERS*, ___ MICH ___; ___ NW2d ___ (2014)?
