Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

Plaintiff's confession of error is REJECTED because it does not fully concur in the relief requested by defendant. Specifically, while plaintiff concurs that defendant is entitled to resentencing, it does not confess error as to the arguments in defendant's Standard 4 brief contending that the circuit judge who imposed the sentence appealed from should be disqualified from sentencing defendant. Accordingly, it would be inappropriate for this Court to simply remand for resentencing before the same circuit judge without addressing those arguments. This case shall be submitted for decision through the ordinary processes of the court with the confession of error being submitted to the panel assigned to decide the case. MCR 7.211(C)(7).
