The Court orders that the motion to raise additional issues on appeal is GRANTED, and that defendant's argument that the trial judge made factual findings when scoring the sentencing guidelines on multiple offense variables that were not supported by the jury's verdict in violation of *People v Lockridge*, 498 Mich 358; 870 NW2d 502 (2015), cert den __ US __; 136 S Ct 590; 193 L Ed 2d 487 (2015), will be considered by this Court on appeal. The prosecutor may file a brief responding to this new issue within 21 days of the clerk's entry of this order.


