Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

Appellant's motion "To impose, to Waive Fee's, or to delay Fee's" is GRANTED only to the extent that fees are waived for this case only.

Appellant's motion for "Extraordinary writ Context indemnification et omnes in uno menoma 'to put all on one table' " is DENIED.

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The September 15, 2016 order entered by the circuit court is not a final order as defined by MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i). MCR 7.203(A)(1). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the September 15, 2016 order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G). Further, to the extent appellant is attempting to appeal the January 25, 2006 order dismissing the case, the claim is untimely because it was not filed within 21 days of entry of the January 25, 2006 order appealed from. MCR 7.204(A)(1).
