William C. Whitbeck, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and 7.216(A)(10), orders:

The claim of appeal filed on June 1, 2007, is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not filed within 21 days of the March 21, 2007, MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) final order, nor was any postjudgment motion filed within 21 days of March 21, 2007. The May 14, 2007 order was not the MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) final order as it was not the first order disposing of the claims of the parties. It did not dispose of any claims that the order of March 21, 2007, had not. Simply adding the language, "This order resolves the last claims in the case and closes the case" does not dispose of any additional claims. That language is required for case management purposes of the trial court and not to determine whether the order is appealable by right to the Court of Appeals. Any appeal must be by application for leave to appeal.
