William C. Whitbeck, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and 7.216(A)(10), orders:

The claim of appeal filed July 18, 2007, is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction because the order being appealed was not a final order at the time that the claim was filed. If an appellant files a motion for reconsideration within 21 days of the entry of a final order, the finality of the order is suspended until the trial court decides that motion and enters an order. An appeal as of right may then be claimed from the final order within 21 days after entry of the order deciding the motion. See MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b). A claim of appeal that is filed before the entry of the order is a premature claim.
