William C. Whitbeck, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and 7.216(A)(10),  
orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because no final judgment has been entered in the case. A dismissal without prejudice does not constitute an adjudication of the rights and liabilities of the parties as required by MCR 7.202(6)(a)(1). See *Detroit v Michigan*, 262 Mich App 542 (2004). Because there is no judgment, the order regarding attorney fees is not postjudgment as required by MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iv). The language in *Detroit* was aimed specifically at cases like this.
