The Court orders that the motion to allow the late filing of defendant's response to the application is GRANTED.

In lieu of granting leave to appeal, pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), the Court further orders that the July 20, 2007, order of the Wayne County Circuit Court, which reversed the district court's denial of defendant's motion to suppress, is REVERSED. Contrary to the circuit court's ruling, MCL 257.648 requires drivers to use a turn signal when changing lanes on a highway. *People v Hrlie*, ___ Mich App ___; ___ NW2d ___ (Docket No. 278053, rel'd November 29, 2007), slip opinion. Therefore, the district court did not err in denying defendant's motion to suppress where the police officer properly conducted a traffic stop after observing defendant's vehicle change lanes without using a turn signal, in violation of MCL 257.648. Accordingly, the matter is REMANDED to the 29th District Court for further proceedings consistent with this order.

This order is to have immediate effect, MCR 7.215(F)(2). The Court retains no further jurisdiction.
