The Court orders that the motion to withdraw is GRANTED because the Court finds, after a full examination of all the proceedings, that the appeal is wholly frivolous.

The circuit court's order terminating respondent-appellant's parental rights to the minor children is AFFIRMED. Within 14 days of the date of certification of this order, withdrawing counsel shall send appellant, by first-class mail, a copy of this order and the transcripts and file a proof of service with the Clerk of this Court as required by MCR 7.211(C)(5)(c). Counsel is hereby notified that this Court may vacate this order granting the motion to withdraw if counsel fails to serve the transcripts on appellant.

The final judgment of affirmance is STAYED for a period of 28 days after service of a copy of the transcripts on the appellant, within which period the appellant may if he so desires, file a written communication with this Court, raising any issue or question he wishes this Court to consider. Any such communication shall be treated by this Court as an application for rehearing
