Henry William Saad, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and 7.216(A)(10), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the December 4, 2007 order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i). Under that rule only the first order disposing of the claims of the parties is the final order. In this case that would be the June 19, 2006 order. The fact that plaintiff untimely filed his motion to amend nine months after the original order of dismissal did not render the second order dismissing a complaint a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i). Furthermore, the order of December 4, 2007, did not reverse the June 19, 2006 final order.
