Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and 7.216(A)(10), orders:

The claim of appeal filed on March 24, 2008, is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. If appellant is trying to appeal the district court order entered February 12, 2008, on remand from the circuit court, the claim of appeal is dismissed because there is no appeal directly to the Court of Appeals from district court. See MCR 7.203(A)(1). If appellant is trying to appeal the circuit court order of December 21, 2007, which remanded to the district court, the claim of appeal is dismissed because a circuit court order entered in an appeal from district court is not appealable by right to the Court of Appeals. See MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a).
