Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and 7.216(A)(10), orders:

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.

The claim of appeal from the April 28, 2008 order and the motion for immediate consideration [of the] stay of eviction are DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. When a law or court rule requires a party to appeal an order of a lower court to the circuit court before filing an appeal with this Court, the party cannot file a claim of appeal to challenge the circuit court order that resolved the appeal before it. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a). Based on this jurisdictional rule, this Court cannot accept appellants' claim of appeal and the motion for immediate consideration [of the] stay of eviction because they seek to challenge the order of the Wayne Circuit Court that resolved their appeal of an order from the 18th District Court. MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) and MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a).
