Christopher M. Murray, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10), orders:

The complaint for superintending control is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with a conforming brief and a proof of service for that conforming brief. A writ of prohibition does not exist. Pursuant to MCR 3.302(C), the filing is a complaint for superintending control. Under MCR 7.206(D)(1)(b), that complaint was required to also have "5 copies of a supporting brief (one signed) conforming to MCR 7.212(C) to the extent possible."
