Re: **People of MI v Attrice Eugene Singleton**

Brian K. Zahra, Judge, acting under MCR 7.217 and MCR 7.219(I), orders:

This cause is REMANDED to the trial court for the appointment of substitute counsel, current counsel having failed to ensure the timely filing of the transcript.

William F. Branch (P-26846), appointed counsel for appellant, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court, within 21 days of the certification of this order, court costs in the sum of \$250 for allowing this appeal to appear on the involuntary dismissal docket. Such costs are personal to the attorney and shall not be charged back to the County or to the State.

The Court, on its own motion, orders Court Reporter Regenia S. Veasy (R-2350) to SHOW CAUSE why the notice of filing transcript in the above matter has not been filed with the Clerk's Office of the Court of Appeals.

If a copy of the notice of filing transcript has not been filed with the Clerk's Office of the Court of Appeals by October 17, 2008, Court Reporter Regenia S. Veasy (R-2350) shall personally appear in the Court of Appeals in its courtroom on the 14th floor of Cadillac Place, located at 3044 West Grand Boulevard, Detroit, Michigan, on Thursday, October 23, 2008, at 1:30 p.m. to explain why said transcript has not been filed, and to further explain why she is not in contempt of this Court.

The Court further orders that Court Reporter Regenia S. Veasy (R-2350) is ASSESSED costs in the amount of \$250 for failing to timely file the transcript or promptly file a motion for an extension of time to file the transcript. The costs shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court within 21 days of the certification of this order.
