The Court orders that the application for leave to file a delayed appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented.

The motion to file an amended application is GRANTED.

The Court further orders, on its own motion pursuant to MCR 7.216(C)(1)(b), that plaintiff's counsel be sanctioned in the amount of \$250.00, payable to the Clerk of this Court. Plaintiff's brief in support of the application is grossly lacking in the requirements for a brief filed in this Court. See MCR 7.205(B)(1) and 7.212(C). Amongst other deficiencies, the brief contains no coherent argument, contains no relevant law or citations and does not contain an accurate statement of the standard of review. This is not the first time plaintiff's counsel has failed to submit a brief in conformity with the rules and practices on this Court. See *Jasper v Williams, et. al.*, unpublished opinion per curiam of the Court of Appeals, issued May 22, 2007 (Dkt. No. 273863) and *Strasson v Ameritech Publishing Inc, et. al.*, unpublished opinion per curiam of the Court of Appeals, issued January 10, 2008 (Dkt. No. 275189). Plaintiff's counsel shall make payment within 21 days from the certification of this order.
