Donald S. Owens, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

Pursuant to MCR 7.202(4) and MCR 7.206(D)(1)(d) plaintiff is required to pay a fee or provide a fee substitute by way of a motion to waive fees and a prisoner account statement. Because plaintiff did not pay a fee the prisoner account statement is being treated as a motion to waive fees and it is DENIED because MCL 600.2963 mandates that a prisoner pursuing a civil action be liable for the filing fees. Any future motions filed with this Court must be accompanied by the full motion fee.

Within 21 days of the certification of this order, plaintiff shall pay to the Clerk of the Court the filing fee of \$375.00 and a motion fee of \$100.00 because the prisoner account statement shows a balance equal to or in excess of this amount. MCL 600.2963(2). Additionally, **plaintiff shall submit a copy of this order and refile the pleadings with the payment.** Failure to comply with this order will result in the appeal not being filed in this Court.

The Clerk of this Court shall furnish two copies of this order to plaintiff and return plaintiff's pleadings with this order.
