The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The application for leave to appeal is DENIED, and in lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal, this Court REMANDS this matter for further proceedings. The trial court is directed to order that psychiatric evaluations occur within 45 days of the Clerk's certification of this order and to hold an evidentiary hearing and issue an order regarding physical custody and parenting time within 90 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

The motion for peremptory reversal pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(4) is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the existence of manifest error requiring reversal and warranting peremptory relief within argument or formal submission.

This order has immediate effect.

This Court retains no further jurisdiction.
