The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is GRANTED. The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk’s certification of this order. MCR 7.205(D)(3). This appeal is limited to the issues raised in the application and supporting brief. MCR 7.205(D)(4).

On its own motion the Court orders this cause REMANDED to the trial court to permit defendant to move for appointment of appellate counsel. Counsel may be appointed to represent defendant on appeal if the defendant requests the appointment of counsel on remand and is indigent. Defendant shall have 21 days from the date of the Clerk’s certification of this order in which to move for appointment of appellate counsel.

It is the responsibility of defendant’s trial lawyer to inform the defendant of this order and to assist the defendant in moving for appointment of appellate counsel.

This Court retains jurisdiction.

Gleicher, J. would deny the prosecutor’s application for leave to appeal.
