David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

On the Court's own motion, the claim of appeal is DISMISSED because appellant, a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, filed the subject claim of appeal even though he owes an outstanding fee to this Court in *Nathan Wilson v Dept of Corrections*, Docket No. 261031. A prisoner who is under the Department's jurisdiction cannot file another civil appeal or original action until the prisoner pays the outstanding balance owed in an earlier civil appeal or original action filed while under the Department's jurisdiction. MCL 600.2963(8).

Accordingly, the motion to correct this Court's assessment of appellant's action is DENIED.
