Pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, the Court REMANDS this case to the Kent Circuit Court to enter an amended judgment of sentence granting the defendant sentencing credit of 84 days for the period of time that he was incarcerated in jail as a condition of probation. His incarceration was imposed as part of the sentence in this case, in lieu of work crew or community service hours, and sentence credit is required in that circumstance. See *People v Sturdivant*, 412 Mich 92; 312 NW2d 622 (1981), modified in *People v Whiteside*, 437 Mich 188; 468 NW2d 504 (1991).

In all other respects the application is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented. We do not retain jurisdiction.
