

William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the April 24, 2013 order denying a motion for reconsideration is plainly not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Further, the claim of appeal cannot be saved by treating it as being taken from the March 29, 2013 order regarding parenting time which is not a final order as defined in MCR 7.202(6). MCR 7.203(A)(1). The postjudgment order regarding parenting time cannot be considered an order affecting the custody of a minor under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the either the March 29, 2013 or April 24, 2013 order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).

Appellant's affidavit of indigency is treated as a motion to waive fees, and the motion is GRANTED for this case only.


